- The Hirer and the Band Leader agree that the equipment and instruments of each musician performing for an Engagement are not available for use by any other person except by specific permission of the musician.
- The Hirer shall ensure a safe supply of electricity and the security of the musicians and their property at the venue.
- The Hirer shall not make or permit the making of any audio and/or visual recording or transmission of the musicians' performance without the prior written consent of the musicians.
- This Agreement may not be modified or cancelled except by mutual consent, in writing signed by both parties.
- Any rider attached hereto and signed by both parties shall be deemed incorporated into this Agreement.

We all know that the best way to create an atmosphere is through music. If you run a traditional pub or a modern bar, a hotel or restaurant, live music can help you build a successful business. From a singer songwriter to a rock tribute act, from a solo pianist to a swinging big band, from a girl group to a string quartet, you can find the style of music best suited to your venue.

The Licensing Act 2003 will come into force during 2005 and will replace the existing licensing system which includes, amongst others, the Public Entertainment Licence. In fact the legislation reforms the alcohol, entertainment and late night refreshment schemes into a single licensing system which will be administered by local authorities.

The types of entertainment that must be listed on the operating schedule for this licence include live music, recorded music and the facilities for dancing and making music. The Department for Culture, Media and Sport has highlighted to local authorities the need to encourage and promote live music for the wider cultural benefit of the community as a whole.

To help venues in staging future live music events, the Musicians' Union has created a LIVE MUSIC KIT.
